#### **PIR Sensor Counters**

These counters are waterproof up to IP65 and are perfect for measuring footfall outdoors, such as on public footpaths. The PIR registers counts via passive infrared, detecting changes in body heat to record a count.





#### Radio Beam

The radio beam units enable us to pick up counts over a greater gap which is the best solution when counting Car Park entrances, roads and any areas where the distance between the sensors could be quite large.
